



WOMEN OF WOODLAWN WHO MADE A DIFFERENCE

On August 26th, the Highlight Pro Skydive Team dropped in to Woodlawn (literally) to help us celebrate National Women's Equality Day and the 100th Anniversary of the ratification of the 19th Amendment. Highlight Pro Skydive Team is an all-female team of professional skydivers who celebrate the tenacious and fierce women who led the suffrage movement more than a century ago. They were a natural partner for Woodlawn, as we have a rich legacy of suffragettes and remarkable women.

That sunny August morning, their yellow parachutes dotted the blue sky, and one by one, four fearless women jumped from a helicopter hovering over New York City and landed on the meadow in front of Alva Belmont's mausoleum. The group then toured the cemetery and placed yellow roses on the gravesites of our suffragettes, Elizabeth Cady Stanton and Madam CJ Walker among them.
