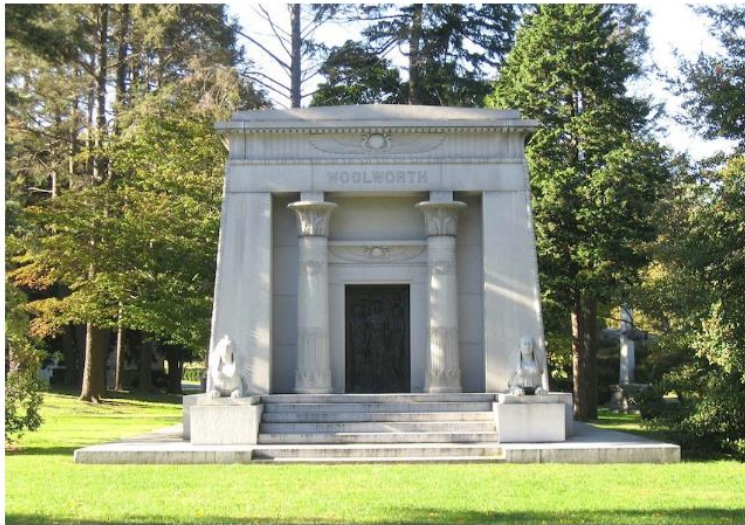


## Woodlawn Conservancy Names New Executive Director
